Our bylaws for Martelle Christian Church (MCC) require a yearly congregational meeting on the third Sunday of January to conduct the annual election of any qualified candidates for the position of elder, deacon, deaconess and any other relevant business (Article IV, Section 2).

Nominations for these positions are advertised within the congregational members for election. Nominations will be reviewed by the current Eldership and ballots prepared for the election.

Along with the biblical requirements some subjective terms will be considered. They may consist of being an active member, regular attenders participating in church activities, (i.e. Sunday School, Worship Service, night Bible Study Group). Will they be willing to give of their time to help this body of Christ in serving their brothers and sisters? Do they have skills or gifts that will enable them serve in ministries? Do they have a certain ministry they want to be involved in? Do they have ideas that will help serve this body better? How can we improve on our service to others?

One area our current Eldership has recognized is that we have not done well in enabling the Deacons and Deaconess' in being an active body working together for the betterment of MCC. We are planning on having a meeting with all Deacons and Deaconess' in early 2024 to see how we might be able to encourage more active participation as a group.
